

Welcome to the Baha'i Garden Holy Sites

*May I bring to your attention some information to consider
as you prepare for this visit.*

*The Bahá'í Gardens are religious and holy sites open to the public without charge.
Photography is welcomed, except inside the Shrines.*

*From experience we have found our visitors appreciate being reminded in advance that
the gardens and terraces offer a beautiful approach to the Shrine and Inner Gardens,
places considered sacred to the Baha'is.
Modest dress is expected, as is behavior that is considerate of the sensitivities of others.
(Attire should cover chest, back and shoulders and almost reach the knees.
A shawl is acceptable over tank tops).*

*The landscaping, ongoing maintenance and restoration of the holy sites
are entirely funded by donations from the world-wide Baha'i community. We ask you
to respect their sacred character and help us keep them clean and beautiful.*

*For the Haifa terraces, comfortable low-heeled shoes with good traction
are recommended because of the steepness of the 750 terrace steps,
and possible slippery pavement from occasional light rain.*

*Kindly inform us in advance of anyone who will be challenged by walking
the steep steps or navigating the pebbled garden paths.*

*During summer months please consider a bottle of water,
a hat and sun screen for each visitor.
Beverages other than water and eating anything, chewing gum
and smoking is not permitted inside the Bahá'í Gardens.*

*If your itinerary includes entering the Shrine and the Inner Gardens
(Haifa 9-12 daily; Akko F-M 9-12)
please know shoes are removed before entering the Shrine
and respectful silence is maintained within.
Photography is not permitted inside the Shrines.*

*As all tours start punctually, please allot plenty of travel time to avoid a late arrival.
On the morning of your visit please call 054 241 4575 to confirm your arrival time.
In the case of delays or rain the itinerary may be modified.*
